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#### **SECTION 1. GETTING STARTED.**

#### **SELECT A RED RIBBON WEEK TEAM LEADER.**

At many schools, guidance counselors fill this role. Once the Red Ribbon Week Team Leader is established, solicit a call-to-action for grade-level volunteers.

#### ESTABLISH GRADE LEVEL RED RIBBON WEEK TEAM AND VOLUNTEERS.

Works best with two teachers per grade level for activities like:

- Copy and distribute student activity material.
  - Creating hallway bulletin boards using daily activity sheets,
  - Planning a program ending school-wide assembly
  - Decorating the school for Red Ribbon Week.

#### REGISTER YOUR SCHOOL AND SUBSCRIBE TO SEYMORE'S FOUNDATION

#### CONDUCT A RED RIBBON WEEK TEAM MEETING.

This group will discuss the program and make decisions on all program activities.

**Example:** Local Law Enforcement enjoys participating in Red Ribbon Week. Inviting a guest speaker from a local Police Department to speak at the closing assembly is always a win-win for the school, school district, and local law enforcement.

#### **SCHOOL DECORATION.**

- The Friday before Red Ribbon Week and after the students have been dismissed for the day, decorate the school. This will promote student engagement when they return to school on the first day of Red Ribbon Week.
- 6 Decorate the school with the program activity sheets created by students.

Beginning October 23, promote the daily activities through morning announcements and repeat the daily message, ending October 31.

#### **MESSAGING PARENTS**

Schedule the recorded parents' message, using the provided script, the week before October 23 and again on October 23. Individual school messages can be edited to meet your school's specifics.

#### **MESSAGING TEACHERS AND STAFF**

#### Seymore Salutes "Kiki's Red Ribbon Week School Celebration"


Seymore's Red Ribbon Week Program is a 5-day drug awareness and prevention program that facilitates school and community engagement across Louisiana. Since the program's inception in 2018, over five thousand students in Elementary and Middle schools have received classroom instruction during the beta test and pilot program.

#### **Community Celebration**

Every October, Kiki's Red Ribbon Week program is available to all Louisiana Elementary schools at no charge. Designed by Seymore's Education Team, the program provides schools with a structured micro curriculum that meets all Louisiana curriculum standards. Seymore's Foundation provides each school with a 5-day drug prevention activity package that includes all teaching components, lesson plans, daily activity sheets, pre/post student assessments, and teacher guides.


#### Kiki Camarena and Red Ribbon Week History.

#### Kiki Camarena and Red Ribbon Week History

Enrique "Kiki" Camarena Salazar was an American intelligence officer for the United States Drug Enforcement Administration. In February 1985, Camarena was kidnapped by drug traffickers hired by Mexican politicians in Guadalajara, Mexico. He was interrogated under torture and murdered. Three leaders of the Guadalajara drug cartel were eventually convicted in Mexico for



Camarena's murder. The U.S. investigation into Camarena's murder led to ten more trials in Los Angeles for other Mexican nationals involved in the crime. The case continues to trouble U.S.—Mexican relations, most recently when one of the three convicted traffickers, Rafael Caro Quintero, was released from a Mexican prison in 2013. Caro Quintero was again captured by Mexican Forces in July 2022.

Red Ribbon Week is an alcohol, tobacco, and other drug and violence prevention awareness campaign observed annually in October in the United States. It began as a tribute to fallen DEA special agent Enrique Camarena in 1985. According to the United States DEA, Red Ribbon Week is the nation's largest and longest-running drug awareness and prevention program.

#### Seymore D'Fair Foundation 100% Me Drug-Free Specialty License Plates

Beginning in the fall of 2019, Louisiana vehicle owners were able to purchase Seymore's "Louisiana is Better with ME 100% Drug-Free!" specialty license plate. This effort helps

When vehicle owners buy a "Louisiana is Better with ME 100% Drug-Free!" plate, proceeds from each purchase are dedicated to supporting drug awareness, education, and prevention programs for elementary and middle schools that promote drug-free lifestyles.



Seymore's new specialty license plate was authorized via executive approval during the 2018 Louisiana Legislative Session. On April 18, 2018, Gov. John Bel Edwards signed HB777, creating Act 283.

#### Seymore Says, "Don't Be a Bird Brain" Avoid Drugs!

Available in 2023, Seymore Says, "Don't Be a Bird Brain" Avoid Drugs! Utilizing the advances of medical research and scientific studies, the Seymore Says "Don't Be a Bird Brain" program was designed and developed by professional educators, applying effective educational strategies supported by evidence and research. The program was created specifically for elementary and middle schools.

The program is designed to introduce the concept of helpful medicines, harmful and dangerous drugs, avoidance encouragement, and first-use prevention or discouragement.

This drug education program has four teaching units across the visual arts,

science, language arts, and health curricula. Each unit is broken into subsections for appropriate grade-level content, and the grade-level progressions are 1-2, 3-4, and 5-6.



# ADDITIONAL PROGRAMS

The modular design allows schools to substitute existing art, science, reading, and health units with Seymore's teaching units to deliver drug prevention instruction seamlessly within the current curriculum infrastructure without disruption.

#### **Drug Prevention Education Requirements – Louisiana Law**

All the education programs produced by Seymore's Foundation have been created to assist Louisiana school districts in complying with Louisiana Revised Statutes 17:154 and 17:404. These laws mandate that all state elementary and middle schools provide annual drug prevention instruction per student per grade level.
